Winner of an International Student Business Competition: A Mysterious Business Case

A team led by Dr. Pradeep Kumar, Faculty of Modern Languages, University of Applied Sciences in Nysa, Poland, won an "international Student Business competition: a mysterious business case", on November 7th, 2023, at the Department of International Business, Prague University of Economics and Business, Prague, Czech Republic.
